- Comments: [i] EPIM: X Semen Ivanovich MAKAROV; at the Soviet Legation/  
Embassy in CANBERRA from April 1943 to June 1949.
- [ii] ATHLETE: X Probably a coverword for a type of agent.
- [iii] BYVShLJ: X i.e. "FORMER" or "CI-DEVANT"; unidentified cover-  
name. Also occurs in MOSCOW's Nos. 434 of 10th  
November 1945 (3/NBF/T132, Item 1) and 213 of 4th  
May 1946 (3/NBF/T1895) and CANBERRA's Nos. 259 of  
14th November 1945 (3/NBF/T132, Item 2) and 155 of  
13th July 1947 (3/NBF/T773).
- [iv] KUZNETSOVA: X Probably Raissa SZAJEWSKI, née HIRSCH, a ballet teacher  
known professionally as Madame KOUSNETZCVA; associated  
with the pro-Soviet Russian Social Club in SYDNEY.
- [v] REPINA: X Almost certainly a member of the family of Ivan  
Dimitri REPIN, prominent member of the pro-Soviet  
section of the Russian community in SYDNEY: either  
Alexandra REPINA (his wife), Ethel Alice REPINA  
(his sister-in-law) or Dr Stella REPINA HOTIMSKY  
(his daughter).
- [vi] SMIRNOVA: X Probably Elsie LFAHY, formerly (1941 to at least  
1947) SMIRNOFF/SMIRNOVA, formerly SURREST; née  
POCLICCHI; associated with the pro-Soviet Russian  
Social Club in SYDNEY.
